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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 174 dated 13.10.2017 registered at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur, Punjab, for the offence under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379-B, 427 and 506 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Vide order dated 02.02.2018, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The order dated 02.02.2018, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
