Petitioner is aggrieved by order dated 29.3.2019 (Annexure-P-1), passed by learned Additional District Judge, Jalandhar, vide which after admitting appeal and while disposing application for stay of judgment and decree dated 9.5.2018 (Annexure-P-2), passed by learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar, and execution, learned Additional District Judge, Jalandhar, vide impugned order, stayed the operation of impugned judgment and decree, subject to deposit of mesne profit, as ordered above. Arrears were ordered to be paid immediately within one month from the date of passing of order. Subsequent mesne profits are ordered to be paid every year on 7th July, starting from year 2019 itself.

After going through file, I am of view that while staying operation of judgment and decree, trial Court has imposed some conditions. While exercising revisional powers, this Court does not deem it proper to interfere in said order. If petitioner feels that he is willing to deposit lesser mesne profit, he can always make prayer before trial Court and it is for trial Court to take decision thereon. No ground to interfere in impugned order. Thus, revision petition is dismissed.
