AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 19.12.2018, passed by this Court in CWP No. 31337 of 2018. The said order is reproduced below:

“Petitioner fears threat to his life at the hands of private respondents. He has also filed representation, Annexure P-1.

Petition is disposed of with the direction that representation preferred by petitioner may be looked into.”

Reply dated 8.8.2019 by way of affidavit of Mr. Navraj Sandhu, Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana, Home Department was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the enquiry report dated 23.7.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
