Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case

On 03.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“Sardar Jagroop Singh, father of petitioner no.2, is present in Court.

The petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 and 5. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The

petitioners have submitted a representation dated 02.05.2019, Annexure P-4 to respondent no.2.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. Respondent No.2 is also requested to make effort to resolve the dispute amicably. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 09.05.2019.”

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of State has submitted that respondent Nos.4 and 5 have been joined inquiry and they have suffered statement that they do not have any objection to the marriage of the petitioners. He further submits that the petitioners were not present.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is unable to controvert this position.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous. However, petitioners shall be at liberty to file fresh one, if they still have any threat to their life and liberty.
