This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 05.10.2018 under Sections 341, 379, 295, 323, 506, 332 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Mohkampura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar. The petitioner apprehend his arrest at the hands of Police.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On 06.05.2019, while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

*“Notice of motion for **16.8.2019**.*

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Nishan Singh has apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Nishan Singh further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.05.2019 is made absolute. However, it is made clear that this order shall remain operative till the filing of the final report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
