Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.243 dated 20.11.2014 under Section 21/27/59 of the N.D.P.S. Act and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation. There is no other case under N.D.P.S. Act against the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 05.10.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
