[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that the revision petition can be disposed of by directing the learned Appellate Court to decide Civil Appeal No. 33 of 2019 in a time bound manner, subject to the petitioners furnishing security in terms of Order 41 (1) (3) of the Code of Civil Procedure to the satisfaction of the learned Appellate Court.

[2] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the revision petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the learned Appellate Court to consider and decide Civil Appeal No.33 of 2019 titled as '**Ratinder Singh** *versus* **Jatinder Singh**', as expeditiously as possible, preferably within 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] *In the meantime*, execution proceedings shall remain in abeyance, subject to the petitioners furnishing security in terms of Order 41(1) (3) of the Code of Civil Procedure to the satisfaction of the learned Appellate Court, in accordance with law within 10 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
