HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 24 dated 23.02.2017 registered under Sections 302, 306 and 34 IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

On 05.10.2019, this Court passed the following order :-

“Submits that after registration of the FIR and after conducting the inquiry, the investigating agency come to the conclusion that the deceased committed suicide.

Notice of motion for 11.10.2018.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of her arrest being required, she shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) (i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which she shall loose the benefit of

interim bail allowed to her.

At this stage, Mr. Fatehjeet Singh, Advocate, has appeared for the complainant and filed his memo of appearance which is taken on record.

To be heard along with CRM-M-9470-2017 and CRM-M24799-2017 ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 05.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for any further investigation.

At this stage, Mr. Fatehjeet Singh, Advocate, has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of the complainant in Court today, the same is taken on record.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and is of the view that since the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated 05.10.2018 passed by this Court and is not required for any further investigation, I deem it appropriate to confirm the order dated 05.10.2018.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 05.10.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
