The present petitions are for quashing of FIR No.0055 dated

28.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Women Cell, S.A.S. Nagar.

Petitioners and respondent No.2 along with their counsel have made statement that they have fully settled their present dispute by way of compromise arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and has sought to accept the settlement placed on the record as Annexure-'A', now, exhibited as 'Ex.Px' and that they have signed the same voluntarily without any undue influence, coercion or pressure. They have further stated that they do not have objection if the FIR in question is quashed on the basis of settlement (Ex.Px) arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '*Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petitions is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.0055 dated 28.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Women Cell, S.A.S. Nagar and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

Both the petitions stand disposed off.
