AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 20.12.2017 passed by this Court in bunch of writ petitions (main being CWP No.14830 of 2017).

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

"Accordingly, the present writ petitions are disposed of, with a direction to the competent authorities, to take into consideration the above-said decision of the State Government dated 21.11.2017 and process the case of the petitioners on individual basis and pass orders, accordingly, within a period of 4 months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. It will be open to respondent No.1 to nominate a designated competent authority so that no contradictory

orders are passed. Wherever the relief is to be granted, the benefits be paid forthwith, as per the decision of the State Government. In case the necessary relief is to be denied, speaking order be passed and communicated to the concerned petitioner(s).”

Learned State Counsel has produced order dated 28.08.2019 today in the Court, same is taken on record, copy of order is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 28.08.2019.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
