Prayer in the petition is for grant anticipatory bail in FIR No.0120 dated 09.04.2019 registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that incident is result of matrimonial discord between the complainant and sister of the accused and a divorce case is pending. Hence, he submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

It is apparent from the order passed by the learned Sessions Judge that the complainant suffered 18 injuries whereas his mother Kanta Devi suffered 4 injuries. Apart from other injury, which had been inflicted with iron rod, there is also a fracture injury. All these injuries are attributed to the petitioner. Hence, no ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
