Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.136 dated 21.12.2018 registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Human Smuggling Act, 2012 at Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the son of the petitioner-Ankit Sharma and respondent No.4-complainant Nikhil Mahajan were friends and they decided to travel abroad and in that process, they came across Kartar Singh and Satinder Kaur. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that both of them had paid a huge amount to the aforesaid two persons and, thereafter, instead of sending them to Australia, they were send to Malasyia from where respondent No.4-Nikhil came back and has registered the present FIR against Ankit Sharma, Kartar Singh, Satinder as well as petitioner-Raj Kumari. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner, Rakesh Kumar and Krishana Murti are harassed by the police.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Som Dutt has submitted that during the investigation, petitioner-Raj Kumari along with two persons Rakesh Kumar and Krishan Murti are found innocent and warrants against accused Kartar Singh and Satinder are issued for 21.11.2019. It is further stated that the son of petitioner, Anikt Sharma has not returned back so far and he is also one of the accused.

In view of the same, no further action is called for and the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
