Through this petition, the petitioner has sought for quashing of FIR No.14 dated 11.01.2018 registered under Sections 304-A, 337, 338 IPC at Police Station GRP Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 5.2.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statement recorded qua the compromise and the Magistrate was directed to send the report with regard to the genuineness of the compromise. Pursuant to the same, report of the concerned Magistrate has been received through a letter dated 30.03.2018 from the District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, which shows that the complainant did not appear to make any statement regarding the compromise.

In view of the above, it is clear that there is no compromise between the parties.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
