Vide order dated 11.10.2018, the petitioner was released on interim bail till the receipt of FSL report.

Learned State counsel submits that six more cases of NDPS Act are pending against the petitioner and he has been convicted in one case for a period of 10 years. Learned State counsel also submits that now the FSL report has been received and the recovery is commercial.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves application for regular bail within a period of one week, the trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.
