Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to hold proper inquiry in case FIR No. 68 dated dated 31.01.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC by some independent agency or an officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that for the redressal of her grievance, petitioner made a representation dated 28.02.2019 (Annexure P6) to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh at Narnaul, but still no action has been taken thereon.
