The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.23 dated 25.3.2017, registered at Police Station Moga Sadar, District Moga, under Sections 336/34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 on the basis of compromise dated 29.9.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 10.4.2019, report dated 19.6.2019 has been received from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
