After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation with regard to the grievances which are the subject matter of the writ petition with directions to the respondent to consider and decide the same expeditiously.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case any such representation is made within four weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondent in accordance with law within three months thereafter. Needless to mention, if aggrieved with the decision of the respondent, the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
