The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0045 dated 15.03.2019 registered under Sections 307, 34 of the IPC and Sections, 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 15.05.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

As per the allegations in the FIR, there was a sudden dispute on account of fixing of barbed wire between the two parties and the petitioner fired with his licensee 12 bore gun, however, the complainant hid himself behind the wall and the fire shot did not hit any person. On 13.05.2019, it was stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is a compromise between the parties (Annexure P-2) and learned State counsel has sought time to verify the same. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harvinder Singh, submits that there is a compromise

between the parties as per the verification made by the police. List again on 29.05.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 15.05.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhchain Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 15.05.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
