Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 25.3.2019 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 307, 341, 324, 323, 427, 379, 148, 149, IPC, registered at Police Station Chattiwind, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner had hit the complainant on his left arm with hockey stick and this injury was found to be simple in nature. The petitioner is 22 years of age and is in custody for over a month. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Dilbagh Singh states that other accused are yet to be arrested. There is a CCTV footage showing participation of the petitioner in the said crime.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when he is alleged to have caused simple injury on non-vital part of the complainant, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant him regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the

instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
