GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is willing to surrender before the trial Court and to move an application for grant of regular bail and has thus prayed that some direction may be issued to the trial Court to dispose of such application expeditiously especially keeping in view the fact that the parties have now compromised the matter.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case, the petitioner choses to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and moves application for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 3 days from filing of such application while also keeping in view the fact that the parties are stated to have compromised the matter.
