The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 183 dated 22.07.2018, registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 506 and 148 of the IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda, Punjab.

The operative part of the order dated 17.10.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and the petitioner has received three injuries and on the complaint of the petitioner, DDR No. 43 was registered. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner even remained admitted in the hospital for a considerably long time.

Notice of motion for 04.12.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation, however, he may be required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.10.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is directed that if the petitioner is required for any further investigation, he will appear and join investigation as and when a written notice is issued by the Investigating Officer in this regard.
