Petitioner Parshant Sharma has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.124 dated 29.8.2014, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the pendency of the proceedings before the trial Court, the complainant has entered into a compromise with the accused and the application for compounding the offence was moved on 05.5.2015. Pursuant to the same,

the statements of the parties were recorded by the trial Court. It is contended that the application is still pending and the complainant is not appearing before the trial Court.

Considering the above status, no ground is made out for invoking the extra-ordinary powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR. However, the trial Court is directed to decide the application filed by the petitioner under Section 320 Cr.P.C., expeditiously.
