Present petition was filed with following substantive prayer:-

“It is therefore prayed that the petition may kindly be allowed and direction to respondent No.5 i.e. Central Bureau Investigation, Chandigarh or any independent investigating agency to investigate into the allegations leveled by the petitioner against the accused persons i.e. respondent No.6 to 10 by filing a complaint dated 22.09.2012 (Annexure P-1) and subsequent representations made by him from time to time, so that the true facts of the case be established and thereafter an appropriate legal action may be taken against the accused persons in

accordance with law, in the interest of justice.”

In response to the notice, reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Indri, Karnal, in which it has been stated that the police has enquired into the matter twice over and found that son of the petitioner had died due to electric shock as he was a mechanic repairing Air Conditioners.

In view of the aforesaid, this Court is of the view that the petitioner should be relegated to the remedy of complaint.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
