Present petition has been filed with following substantive
prayer:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and directions may kindly be issued to respondent No.1 to 4 to take appropriate action on the representation dated 20.08.2018 (Annexure P-9) and investigates the same in accordance with law and booked the accused/respondent No.5, in the interest of justice.”

Pursuant to the notice, reply has been filed, according to which, police after completing the investigation has also obtained opinion from Board of Doctors of Civil Hospital, Ferozepur, according to which cause of death is “Acute Tubular Necrosis”. Respondent No.5 is a practicing Doctor. Petitioner alleges medical negligence.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that this is not a fit case for issuance of direction. Hence, petitioner is relegated to the remedy of criminal complaint.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
