MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.986 dated 09.11.2017 registered under Sections 18-A, 18-C of Drugs and Cosmetic Act 1940, Sections 15 (2) (B) of Indian Medical Council Act 1956 and Sections 336, 419 and 420 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

On 08.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegations against the petitioner is that he had stored allopathic drugs in his shop without any licence. In fact, allopathic drugs were stored there by Dr. Rahul, who has moved application to CMO and the police for cancellation of FIR.

Notice of motion for 11.01.2019.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his

arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 08.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Naresh. submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.10.2018 is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
