The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under
Section 439 Cr.P.C. Seeking regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the prosecutrix
and her mother turned hostile but a bare perusal of the statement recorded
under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she categorically stated that she put her thumb
impression on the statement which was recorded by the learned Magistrate.

As per status report, out of 11 witnesses, 9 witnesses have been
examined.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence and the fact that
the trial is likely to conclude, no case is made out for grant of regular bail.

The present petition is dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within
a period of two months.
