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We have heard learned counsel for the parties on quantum of sentence. This Court has altered the conviction under Section 302 to Section 304, Part-I IPC.

Learned counsel for the convicts vehemently argued that the convicts are married and they are the sole bread earners of their families. They prayed that a lenient view may kindly be taken by taking into consideration the young age of the convicts.

However, in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the convicts are sentenced to undergo 10 years rigorous imprisonment and to pay a fine of Rs.10,000/- each and in default of payment of fine to further undergo six months additional simple imprisonment each for the offence under Section 304 Part I IPC. The convicts are directed to surrender before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal within 24 hours to undergo the sentence imposed by this Court.
