Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.56 dated 30.03.2019 under Sections 365, 366-A, 376, 120-B IPC, 1860 (the offence punishable under Sections 3 & 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 was added later on), registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated September 13, 2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balvir Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated September 13, 2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
