The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 19.03.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 13359 of 2018. The operational part of the order is quoted below:

“In the facts and circumstances, while permitting the petitioner to withdraw this writ petition, leaving the issues raised herein open for adjudication in appropriate proceedings, we provide that for refund of the earnest money let an application be made by the petitioner before the respondent-Corporation within a week from today, with a direction to respondent to take an appropriate decision in accordance with law in respect of the refund of the amount. Needless to say, unless there is any legal impediment the amount shall be refunded.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, a short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Arshdeep Singh Thind, IAS, General Manager, Food Corporation of

India, Regional Office, Punjab, Chandigarh has been filed today in Court and same is taken on record. Along with reply, order dated 16/19.08.2019 has been annexed whereby the claim of the petitioner has been rejected. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order passed by the respondent is illegal and he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
