1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos. 5 to 8.

2. The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 1.1.2000 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 17.7.1992. They have also moved a representation before

the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rewari, District Rewari (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

3. Notice of motion qua respondents No. 1 to 4 at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Dr. Sushil Gautam, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 and a copy of paper-book has been supplied to him.

5. Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and validity of marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Rewari, District Rewari to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-6).

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
