The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0199 dated 20.04.2019 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had submitted a forged ITI certificate while obtaining the job of ALM in UHBVN. Learned counsel, however, contends that the petitioner had resigned from the job in the year 2015 much prior to the registration of the FIR in the year 2019. He also contends that the petitioner has not obtained any benefit of ITI certificate thereafter. He further contends that now-a-days the petitioner is plying a taxi.

This Court, by the order dated 07.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 07.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
