Reply by way of short affidavit of Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector, Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur, filed in Court is taken on record, according to which the possession has been delivered to the petitioner on 17.09.2019.

Mr. Deepak Verma, counsel for respondent No.3, who has put in appearance and filed power of attorney, submits that revision petition has been preferred by one Monika Heera, a co-sharer, in which *status quo* has been ordered by the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar, vide order dated 18.09.2019, which has been endorsed to the SDM-cum-Collector, Garhshankar, as well as Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector 1<sup>st</sup> Grade, on 19.09.2019.
