Main Case

The petitioners have filed the present petition for quashing FIR
No. 192 dated 04.07.2018 registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul,
District Mahendergarh, for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 324,
506, 34 IPC on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties and
all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated 08.10.2018, the parties were asked to appear
before Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded with regard to
the compromise.

Report dated 20.11.2018 has been received from learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul wherein it has been stated that the parties have got recorded their statements in respect of the compromise. It has been certified that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between the parties without any pressure or coercion.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 192 dated 04.07.2018 registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners are quashed.
