By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.222 dated 25.7.2018 registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mahendergarh under Sections 323, 325, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Reply of Sh. Mahesh Kumar, H.P.S. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh (Haryana) has been filed by learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 8.10.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Ajit, Kamla and Jagdish and also of complainant Naresh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. The complainant in his statement has further stated that they belong to same family and he does not wish to take any action against the petitioners/accused and have not objection in case the FIR is quashed. The compromise effected between the parties has been placed on record as 'Mark A'.

It has specifically been opined by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.222 dated 25.7.2018 registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mahendergarh under Sections 323, 325, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
