Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.54 dated 07.06.2016 registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner asserts that the petitioner is son of Sh. Jiwan Garg but was not directly involved in the business. Hence, he submits that the petitioner is entitled to anticipatory bail.

On careful perusal of the First Information Report, it is apparent that the petitioner is alleged to be present when deal took place and there are serious allegations against Sh. Jiwan Garg, Prince Garg and Rajan Garg. Hence, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
