Report dated 21.12.2018 of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent/complainant-Lakhwinder Kaur and accused/petitioners Lakhwinder Kaur, Gurpreet Singh, Narinder Kaur, Gurwinder Singh, Amrik Singh and Palwinder Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the

fact that the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 16 dated 05.05.2018 registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur under Sections 323, 325, 354, 354-B, 148 and 149 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
