Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for quashing of Complaint No. 2114 of 2015, dated 28.04.2015, under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act and summoning order dated 05.08.2015 and further to quash all subsequent proceedings arise out of the same.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has apprised the Court that the trial in the impugned complaint is in progress and trial Court has afforded the last opportunity to the defence to conclude the evidence. According to him, 28.08.2019 is the date fixed for the said purpose.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent power under Section 482 Cr.P.C..
