[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to make a mercy representation to the Director, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar National Institute of Technology, Jalandhar, for taking a sympathetic view on the matter.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions states that in case, any such representation is made, the competent authority would take a sympathetic view on the matter and pass appropriate orders within three days from the date of submission of the representation.
