AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.196 dated 17.11.2016 registered under Sections 420, 408 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib.

On the last date the following order was passed:-

“After hearing arguments of learned counsel for the parties, it appears that the parties are ready to settle their dispute. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to pay an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- to the complainant on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 05.04.2019.

Interim order to continue.

Last opportunity is granted.”

Today at the first call counsel for the petitioner Ms. Harmanpreet Kaur had appeared on behalf of Mr. Swarn Tiwana, Advocate and sought an adjournment but I had asked her to find out whether the petitioner had made arrangements to make payment as per the last order and the matter was passed over. Even now Ms. Harmanpreet Kaur, Advocate appears and states that there is no information from the petitioner about the payment but she vehemently seeks one more opportunity.

In my opinion, no further opportunity can be granted. The petitioner has misused the concession of interim relief by getting it extended on false statements and giving false undertakings before this Court.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
