AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J (ORAL)

By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Today an affidavit of Shri Surinder Pal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kartarpur (Jalandhar), has been filed in Court by learned State counsel, giving therein the details of seven other cases registered against the petitioner, with him having been acquitted by the trial Court in one of them, convicted in four of them and with two other cases being still at the trial stage.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case simply because of the fact that he was earlier involved in similar cases and even the Arresting Officer himself became the Investigating Officer, with 120 gms of Alprazolam alleged to have been recovered from the petitioner.

He further submits that the trial is not anywhere near conclusion.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual

merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed, with the petitioner ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
