This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to official respondents to make permanent arrangement for release and disposal of the dirty and sewerage water from village Dhilwan.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3- Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala to consider and decide the representation dated 20.2.2019 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.

3- Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala to consider and decide the

representation dated 20.2.2019 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
