Present petition has been filed for directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and to provide adequate security to the petitioners, so that the respondents No.4 and 5 and other relatives of the petitioners do not interfere in the married life of the petitioners.

This Court has already held in another petition i.e. CRM-M-20457-2019 decided on 06.05.2019 that for enforcement of fundamental right of protection to life and liberty, the remedy is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is not maintainable for protection of fundamental right.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
