Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the FIR No.79 dated 25.07.2018 under Sections 363 and 366 IPC (Sections 376 and 506 IPC as well as Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 were added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar on the basis of compromise dated 08.09.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the FIR in question was registered only against petitioner No.1 Shamsher Singh. Petitioner No.2 Amrik Singh was arrayed as an accused for the reason that he is father of petitioner No.1, otherwise, there is no allegation against him. She further states that in the trial, petitioner Shamsher Singh has been acquitted of the

charge levelled against him vide judgment dated 19.03.2019 passed by the trial Court and, therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having become infructuous.
