This is a petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 15.05.2018, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot.

FIR has got registered by Rozi (paternal aunt of the prosecutrix) on the basis of suspicion that petitioner has kidnapped her nephew.

It has been argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has married with the prosecutrix and she has already given a statement before the coordinate bench in CRM-M-25191-2018 (Annexure P-2) in this regard. He has also placed on record photocopy of the discharge slip of Bhagat Jacha Bacha Kender, Malerkotra which transpires that she has delivered a male child on 25.02.2019.

In this view of the matter, petition is allowed and in the event of his arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
