ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

On 07.05.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Kalawati and Sailesh Kumar, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-4 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 04.05.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent No.2.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. Adjourned to 14.05.2019.”

Learned counsel appearing for the State, on instructions from

HC Balwinder Kumar, has stated that the petitioners have sworn in separate affidavits to the effect that now they do not have any threat to their life and liberty.

Neither the petitioners nor their counsel is present, although case has been called twice.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition, if in future they apprehend any threat to their life and liberty.
