Grievance of the petitioner is that vide decree and judgment dated 04.01.2017 (Annexure P-1), a competent civil Court declared the petitioner to be adoptive son of Sh. Malkiat Singh and Smt. Pritam Kaur. Pursuant thereto, the petitioner vide application dated 04.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) applied for change of name of his adoptive parents in his service record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide notification dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-5), the petitioner is entitled to get the names changed. However, having waited for some time, when no decision on the application Annexure P-4 filed by the petitioner was conveyed, he also submitted representations dated 05.09.2018 and 18.12.2018 (Annexures P-8 and P-9 respectively) which too have not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to

seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 05.09.2018 and 18.12.2018 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
