The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.11.2018 passed in CWP No. 29962 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is quoted below:-

“ On the asking of the court, Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He submits that, in case, it is found that legal notice has been received by the concerned authority, it shall take a decision thereon by passing a speaking order within six weeks from today.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Gurpreet Singh, Legal Assistant, submits that the order of this Court has been complied with and order has been passed, copy of the same would be supplied to the petitioners as well as counsel for the petitioners within one week from today.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

It is made clear that in case the afore-said statement is not adhered to, petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present petition.
