The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 10.12.2018 passed in CWP No. 31156 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is quoted below:-

“ *In case, legal notice has been received in the office of concerned authority, it may look into the same and endeavour to decide expeditiously.* ”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Gurpreet Singh, Legal Assistant, submits that the order of this Court has been complied with and an order has been passed, copy of same would be supplied to the petitioner as well as counsel for the petitioner within one week from today.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

It is made clear that in case the afore-said statement is not adhered to, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition.
