Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.019 dated 24.02.2019 under Sections 323, 325, 34, 506 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added subsequently), registered at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Ramesh Kumar, he along with his brothers Ranjeet and Sunil were going on a motorcycle and had parked the same in front of house of co-accused Rakesh i.e. husband of the petitioner and after some time, when they went to take the motorcycle, Rajesh, who was under the influence of liquor, raised an objection why the bike is parked in front of his house and thereafter, he got provoked and gave a gandasi blow on his head and the petitioner gave danda blows on his hands and feet. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a housewife, she is not involved in any other case and is in

custody since 16.04.2019 and co-accused Rajesh already stands arrested.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady; she is not attributed the injury under Section 307 IPC and is not involved in any other case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing her bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
