ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.416, dated 23.10.2018, under Sections 457, 380, 328, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused Neelam @ Kanchan had gone to the house of the complainant and administered some substance in her tea due to which she became unconscious. On regaining consciousness next day, she found that her ornaments and Rs.60,000/- in cash were missing. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 16.11.2018 and co-accused Neelam @ Kanchan has been granted bail by the trial Court on 23.04.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, states that investigation has been completed and 3 out of 11 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, he is in custody for over 6 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
